Treasurer's Report – Elliott

Bank Balance \$32,600

Deposit for Race School was paid. Waiting for RMM to send invoice to pay for the remainder of Race School.

CRA tax bill for 2024 and 2025 were not paid, and GST for the past 20 months had not been paid.

Elliott went to the bank to pay the bill and was told that a meeting needs to be arranged with the Bank, Tim Johnson, Rob Darlington, Ryan McGowan and one other CMRA executive to make changes to the account. All people must be present to make the changes.

Ryan, Carey and Elliott have access to the digital bank information. The bank account remains under Tim and Rob's names and requires the meeting with the bank to change to current executive member and treasurer.

Transponders

Dave has spoken with AACA and they will loan CMRA 23 transponders for the weekend at NO COST.

Dave is looking into other avenues for transponders as well through RMM members/contacts.

WCC members are bringing 8 extra.

EMRA may be a back up option, would likely need 10 units. EMRA execs need to vote on rentals.

Race Registrations

35 people have registered

Sponsorship

Dave P handed out a list of sponsors for 2026, as well as a description of how they are sponsoring CMRA, a brief description of services offered and a contact person.
